Group Eligibility Policy

Eagle's Nest Retreat Centre is a formation and retreat centre wholly owned and operated by the Roman Catholic Archdiocese of Perth.

The primary purpose of Eagle's Nest is

- to preserve a venue specifically set aside to facilitate young people's growth in faith and development of Christian values through relevant programmes, workshops, training and formation.
- to make a facility available for such activities, primarily to Catholic youth organisations, movements, schools and parishes.
- to also be available for similar use by adult and youth groups from various Christian denominations as well as other complementary groups or organisations.
- to maintain a facility where each group's conduct and activities are consistent with the Church's ethos.
- to provide a restful environment away from the demands of everyday life, where guests are immersed in the gift of God's creation and inspired to worship and reflect.

Please read the following declaration and sign below that you have read and understood it.

- We declare that our group is not affiliated with any non-Christian religious system, philosophy or worldview.
- We are aware and acknowledge that Eagle's Nest is an agency of the Catholic Church, primarily for use by Catholic Youth Organisations, movements, schools and parishes.
- We recognise that the facility has been set aside for the purpose of developing Christian faith and values, and has been blessed as a Place of Christian Worship.
- We undertake to refrain from any practices or teaching foreign to Christian faith and values whilst at Eagle's Nest.
- We undertake to respect all Catholic and Christian symbols at Eagle's Nest including not removing, replacing or covering these symbols.

Swimming Pool Disclaimer – Trained Personnel

Use of the swimming pool at Eagle's Nest is subject to the following disclaimer.

- Patrons are notified that use of the swimming pool is at the patrons' own risk.
- The swimming pool is classified as a Group Three Aquatic Facility under the State Department of Health *Code of Practice*, and as such does not provide a lifeguard service. Accordingly, patrons intending to use the pool must provide their own qualified adult supervision as detailed below.
- The qualified lifeguard shall be actively observing from the poolside (not in the pool) at all times that the pool is in use.
- Particular attention shall be given to children and any patrons who are not competent swimmers.
- Lifeguards shall make themselves familiar with, and enforce, all signs in the pool area, including all behavioural requirements as sign-posted.
- The lifeguard shall hold a current qualification in at least one of the following approved training programs
 1. National unit of competency: 'SRC AQU 003B Respond to an aquatic emergency using basic water rescue techniques' or equivalent, or higher level national unit of competency for aquatic rescue
 2. Performance criteria of Guideline PR 01.12 – Patron Rescue Accreditation for Group 3 Pools - 2008 from the Pool Safety Guidelines or equivalent
 3. Bronze Medallion Award [Section 6.2.5.1 amended 9 September 2009]
